If you want to do something good in the community, Wollongong City Council wants to support you! We have a range of funding grants available to support community events, heritage projects, bands and choirs, NAIDOC Week celebrations and other cultural activities in the region. These programs are accepting applications until Friday 31 March 2023.

Band and choir grants

This program supports not-for-profit bands and choirs that are based in Wollongong and perform locally at public events.

Community event grants

This program aims to encourage a wider range of events in our city, particularly those that bring social and economic benefits to the local area.

Heritage grants

This program encourages conservation projects in heritage places and helps to conserve items that have local cultural significance.

Small cultural grants

This program supports a broad range of activities that enliven our city, build our cultural industry, and encourage people to get involved

NAIDOC Week grants

This program aims to get as many people as possible involved in NAIDOC Week (2–9 July 2023) and celebrate the history, culture and achievements of the local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure Policy

We've revised our policy to support the installation and management of electric vehicle charging stations on Council land. Installing charging stations on public land is providing increased public access to charging infrastructure, encouraging the uptake of electric vehicles.
