2 FLOOD MANAGEMENT UPDATE

2.1 Mullet Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study & Plan

Council has been progressing the review of the Mullet Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study & Plan. This project is funded by the NSW Floodplain Management Program and Council. This project is nearing completion and Community Exhibition has been undertaken.

The Consultant (Rhelm) will provide a summary of the findings, including feedback from the Community Exhibition and key outcomes.

2.2 Brooks Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study & Plan

Council has commenced a review of the Brooks Creek Floodplain Risk Management Study & Plan working with a Consultant. This project is funded by the NSW Floodplain Management Program and Council.

The Consultant (GRC Hydro) will provide a summary and preliminary flood modelling results.
