7 FINANCE AND WEST DAPTO S7.11 DEVELOPMENT CONTRIBUTIONS PLAN

- In November 2024 the Independent Pricing and Regulatory Tribunal (IPART) published a revised draft report on its assessment of the draft West Dapto Development Contributions Plan 2024.
- The Contributions Plan allows Council to provide public services and essential infrastructure for communities in new development areas, like parks, roads and stormwater management.
- Council prepared a submission emphasising its position that the Western Ring Road should be a State infrastructure projected and removed from the 7.11 Plan.

8 BIOCERTIFICATION

- An update on Biodiversity Certification was provided for the benefit of the new Councillors.
- Biodiversity Certification is a streamlined biodiversity assessment process for areas of land proposed for development. The process identifies areas that can be developed after they have been certified and measures to offset the impacts of development. Where land is certified, development may proceed without the usual requirement for site-by-site assessment.
- Development Applications are a lot more streamlined and provides a good outcome for the environment and for the developers.
- Money is collected through the State Housing and Productivity Contribution scheme which is a development charge that helps fund the delivery of infrastructure in high growth areas. It helps deliver essential state infrastructure such schools, hospitals, major roads, public transport infrastructure and regional open space.
