NOTICE OF RESCISSION - COUNCILLORS BRADBERRY, DORAHY AND KERSHAW - COMMEMORATIVE COUNCIL MEETING 7 DECEMBER 2015 - COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS OF 14 SEPTEMBER AND 9 NOVEMBER

Councillors Bradbery, Dorahy and Kershaw have submitted the following Notice of Rescission –

“We the undersigned Councillors, hereby give notice that we wish to move rescission of Council resolutions of –

- 1 14 September 2015, Minute Number 134, in relation to Item 14 – Illawarra 200 Commemorative Council Meeting Proposal, and,
- 2 9 November 2015, Minute Number 160, in relation to Item 18 – Extraordinary Council Meeting Agenda – 7 December 2015”.

Council’s decisions in these matters are as follows:

**Minute Number 134:**

“An Extraordinary Council meeting be held at 6.00 pm on 7 December 2015 as part of Illawarra 200 activities.”

**Minute Number 160**

- “1 The agenda for the Extraordinary Council meeting on 7 December 2015 be endorsed.
- 2 The agenda conclude with a musical item as follows –
  - a ‘The Wollongong Song’, with the agreement of Graham Wilson and the musical band;
  - b The National Anthem, which includes one verse in Dharawal, and one in English.”

Should the Rescission Motion be successful, the following motion will be formally moved –

*“There be an avowal at the Ordinary Meeting of Council on 14 December 2015, to commemorate Illawarra 200 and the transition from the exclusive Aboriginal period to the introduction of the European history, acknowledging our shared history, while embracing our shared values and future as a growing and diverse community”.*
