Reading Challenge 2023 – August/September Minor Prize – Wollongong City Libraries

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Who can enter?

- To enter, you must be:
 - the age of 18 years or older;
 - o be a member of Wollongong City Libraries; and
 - o live in the Wollongong Local Government Area.
- Council employees and their immediate family and/or household members are not eligible to enter. Immediate family means: spouse (including de facto), child, parent, and sibling (and includes 'step' variations of same).

2. How to enter

- To enter, post a short book review (max 100 words) on Facebook or Instagram between 29 August 2023 and midday on 29 September 2023 ('Submission Period').
- The book must correspond to one of the 24 unique reading prompts from the Wollongong City Libraries 2023 Reading Challenge prompt found on the Wollongong City Libraries website https://www.wollongong.nsw.gov.au/library/whats-on/reading-challenge-2023
- The post must:
 - a) contain the hashtag: #gongreads
 - b) contain the tag: @wollongongcitylibraries (Facebook) or @wollongonglibraries (Instagram)
 - c) list the prompt the book corresponds to
 - d) be 'public' able to be found by Wollongong City Libraries.
- Posts that meet the requirements set out in (a) to (d) above, will to be included in the draw to win a 2023 Reading Challenge minor prize valued at over \$150.
- Any entry received after the expiry of the Submission Period will not be included in the draw.
- No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries.
- Council reserves the right to verify your details (including your age and address).

3. The Selection

- The draw will take place on **29 September 2023**. A Council officer will choose the winner at random from all eligible Entries.
- Council will notify the winner via direct message on Facebook or Instagram by 6
 October 2023 ('the Notification').
- Council will confirm that the winner is a library member and currently resides in the Wollongong Local Government Area. If they are not, Council will redraw the winner and repeat the process.
- The winner must make arrangements to collect the prize, in person, from a Wollongong City Libraries branch.

• If the prize remains unclaimed after 8 weeks from the Notification, a new winner will be chosen at random from the original entries.

4. General
