Allocation of a licence for Bulli Senior Citizens Centre

Council is seeking enquiries from not-for-profit community groups who are interested in becoming the licensee of a Council community facility. As a licensee, the successful community group can use the facility for their own programs and services and will be required to manage and operate the building on behalf of Council. At the facility, the licensee is required to retain access to the facility by other groups and individuals.

The community facility available for licensing is Bulli Senior Citizens Centre, 8 Hospital Road, Bulli NSW 2516.

Bulli Senior Citizens Centre is a multipurpose community facility with a focus on providing community support, educational, social, and cultural activities to the local community. Council aims for the facility to be available for use by other groups and individuals, not just the licensee, and for the current regular hirer groups to retain existing use of the facility.

Any group wanting to register an interest in being the licensee will need to undertake a self-assessment and lodge a Notification of Interest Form by 5pm on Friday 22 September 2023.

Proposed Licence for Coalcliff Community Hall

Council is proposing to grant a licence to AUSTI. Dance and Physical Theatre Inc. for physical, social, cultural or intellectual development or welfare of the community including the hiring of specified rooms at Coalcliff Community Hall, Lot X DP 397976, 270 Lawrence Hargrave Drive, Coalcliff NSW 2508. The proposed licence is for a term of up to 10 Years.

Pursuant to Chapter 6 Part 2 of the *Local Government Act 1993*, Council is required to advertise the proposed granting of any lease or licence as the land is classified as Community Land.

Submissions are sought from the public and should be in writing quoting Council's reference number ECM 24501378. Any submissions should be clearly outlined and based on the effect of granting the licence will have on the existing or future use of the Community Land. Planning Proposal – Review of large R2-zoned lots in the Illawarra Escarpment foothills

Council is seeking feedback on a Planning Proposal to rezone certain large R2-zoned lots interfacing the Illawarra Escarpment. This follows the 3 April 2023 Council Resolution and the 17 August 2023 Gateway Determination by the NSW Department of Planning and Environment to progress the Planning Proposal to Public exhibition.

If adopted by Council, the zones and controls for certain land interfacing the escarpment will be revised through amendments being made to Wollongong Local Environmental Plan 2009.

Managing flood risk in our catchments

We're working on Floodplain Risk Management Studies and Plans for both the Allans Creek catchment (Mount Keira, West Wollongong, Figtree, Mount Kembla, Unanderra, Farmborough Heights and Berkeley) and Fairy & Cabbage Tree Creeks catchment (between Towradgi and the southern end of Wollongong). We're planning ways to manage the risks from floods and are asking the community to be involved in this planning.
