An accessible viewing area will be near the main stage in the Arts Precinct.

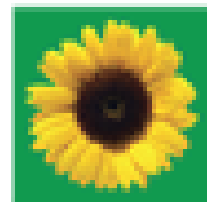


I can ask the staff or volunteers if I need information or help on the day.

- Performances
- Cultural stalls
- Information table



Lower Crown Street will have:

- Food stalls and restaurants
- Let's Dance – try a new dance
- Performances
- Information table



Lower Crown Street Mall will have:

- Performances
- Kids' activities
- All ages, all abilities interactive spaces
- Market stalls
- Information table

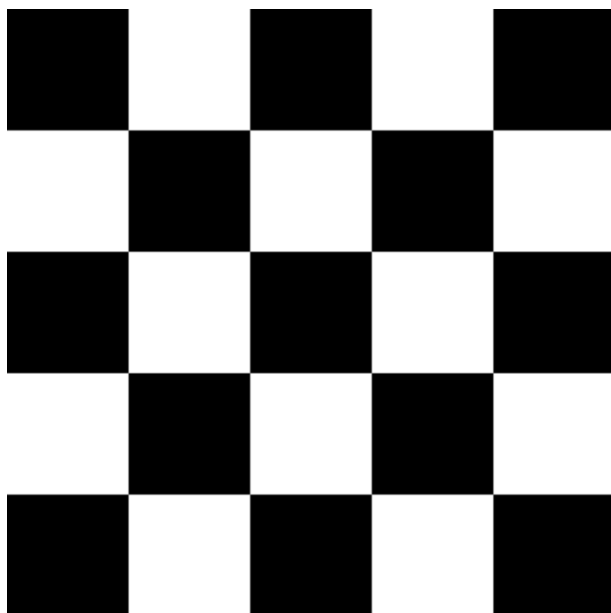
