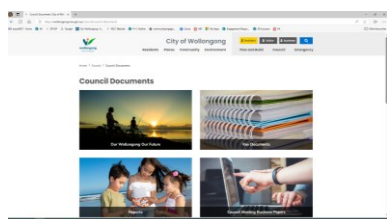


Wollongong City Council wrote this plan.

- Talked to us.



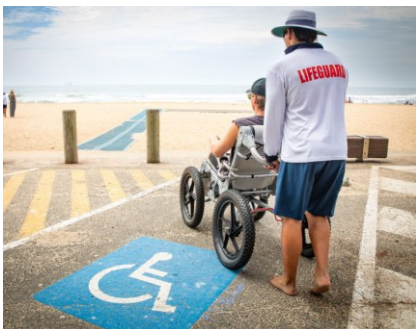

- Teach our staff about disability and inclusion.

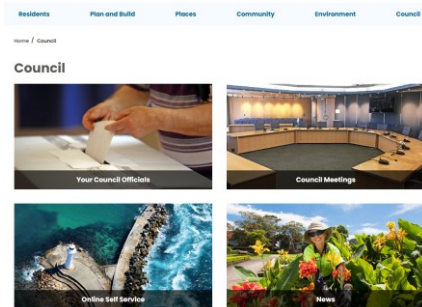


- Share real stories of people with disability.

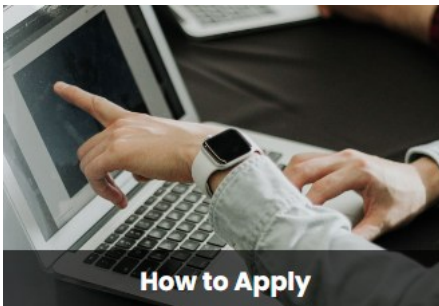

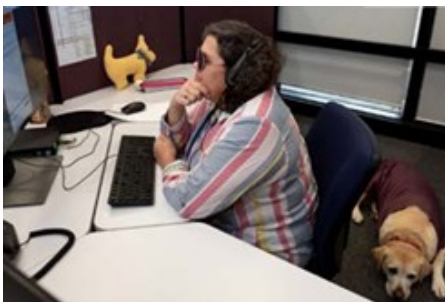

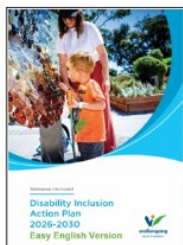


- Give extra help when someone needs it.

We will tell you each year what we have done.

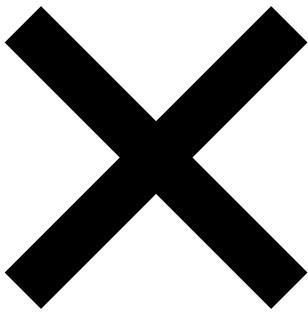


We will review this plan every 5 years.

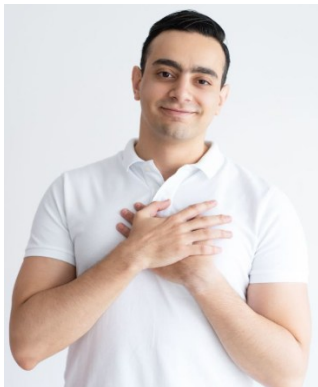
