### 2. How to enter

- To enter, place a completed attendance slip ('Entry') in the collection box at any branch of the Wollongong City Libraries.
- Entry slip will be available from program presenter at the end of each program.
- You may submit one Entry per child per program attended.
- Entries must be submitted between 9am on Monday 1 August 2022 and 1pm on Friday 23 September 2022 ('Submission Period') to be included in the draw to win the Cruzee Balance Bike and an Azur helmet ('Prize'). The Prize is valued at \$270.
- Entries will not be accepted after the close of the Submission Period.
- No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected Entries.

### 3. The Selection

- A draw will take place at each branch of the Wollongong City Libraries on Tuesday 27 September 2022. A Council will choose the winner at random from all eligible Entries.
