

WIN AN E-BIKE AND HELMET

Borrow a physical item from your local Wollongong City Libraries branch between Monday 1 August and Saturday 24 September 2022 and go into a draw to win a NCM Milano 28" e-Bike and helmet. There is a limit of one entry per person each day.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Who can enter?

- To enter, you must:
 - be over the age of 18 years;
 - be a Wollongong City Libraries member; and
 - live in the Wollongong Local Government Area.
- Council employees and their immediate family and/or household members are not eligible to enter. Immediate family means: spouse (including de facto), child, parent and sibling (and includes 'step' variations of same).

2. How to enter

- To enter, borrow a physical item from any branch of the Wollongong City Libraries and place a copy of your loans receipt ('Entry') in the collection box.
- You may submit one Entry per person for each day that you borrow a physical item.
- Entries must be submitted between 9am on Monday 1 August 2022 and 1pm on Saturday 24 September 2022 ('Submission Period') to be included in the draw to win the NCM Milano 28" e-Bike and helmet ('Prize'). The Prize is valued at over \$1800.
- Entries will not be accepted after the close of the Submission Period.
- No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected Entries.

3. The Selection

- The draw will take place on Tuesday 27 September 2022. The winner will be chosen at random by an officer of Council.
- Council will notify the winner by e-mail and/or telephone on Wednesday 28 September 2022 ('the Notification').
- The winner must make arrangements to collect the prize, in person, from the nearest branch of Wollongong City Libraries.
- If the prize remains unclaimed after 8 weeks from the Notification, a new winner will be chosen at random from the original Entries submitted during the Submission Period.

4. General

- Council's decision in relation to any aspect of the draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Loan receipts for online / digital items are ineligible. .
- Council reserves the right to verify the name and membership status of the winner.

5. Privacy Protection Notice

- Purpose of collection: Council will collect the personal information of individuals who submit an Entry in order to be able to contact the winner
- Intended recipients: Council staff.

- Supply: While the supply of personal information is voluntary, the information provided will enable your participation in the draw.
- Access / Correction: Your personal information may be accessed by you and Council. A request to access, update or correct any information should be directed to Wollongong City Council.
- Storage: The personal information collected will be stored by Council for the purposes indicated above. However, any personal information may be disclosed as required by law.
